










TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Canada's climate varies tremendously, with warm days in summer and sub-zero temperatures in winter. The climate and daylight hours can be very different in the south compared to the north.

Summer (June to August) brings long, warm, sunny days to most regions. This is the best time to see grizzly and black bears as well as whales. Experience 16 to 22 hours of daylight, and midnight sun in the north of the state.

Autumn (September to November) sees temperatures drop and foliage turn all shades of yellow, orange and red. October to November is the best time to see Polar bears and you may still see grizzly and black bears, as well as whales through to October. Snow begins to fall from October/November.

Winter (December to February) brings cold weather with temperatures dropping below zero. Cities and towns are geared to challenge the cold surroundings with many having covered walkways and indoor malls to protect from the elements. Snow falls most of winter in many regions. The Northern Lights are best viewed in winter.

Spring (March to May) sees days getting longer and temperatures slowing rising. Snow starts to melt away in March/April and wildflowers begin to bloom. The whale and bear watching season generally begins in May. The Northern Lights may be seen through to March in some parts.

ELECTRICITY

110V 60Hz. An adaptor is required.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Canada must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia and obtain the Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA) prior to travel, see www. cbp.gov/esta for more details. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas, and other travel requirements for the countries you intend visiting from the Australian Government at smartraveller.gov.au.

TIME

There are six main time zones in Canada. Pacific Daylight Time (PDT - Vancouver) is 17 hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST), Mountain Daylight Time (MDT - Edmonton) is 16 hours behind AEST, Central Daylight Time (CDT - Winnipeg) is 15 hours behind AEST, Eastern Daylight Time (EDT - Toronto) is 14 hours behind AEST, Atlantic Daylight Time (ADT - Halifax) is 13 hours behind AEST and Newfoundland (St John's) is 12 1/2 hours behind AEST. Daylight Saving Time is observed from March to November when clocks are turned forward by one hour.

CURRENCY

Canadian Dollar (CAD)

TIPPING

Tipping is expected in restaurants, bars and taxis. As a guide expect to pay 15% to 20% of the bill, CAD1 per bag for hotel porters and 10% of the tour price for tour guides.

LANGUAGE

French is the official language in Québec City and Montréal however English is widely spoken.


The best part of any journey is the experiences you have along the way, leaving you with memories to relive long after the holiday is over.

BEAR VIEWING

Seeing these powerful animals in the wild is an experience you'll never forget. Grizzly bears can be found throughout the Canada wilderness or fishing for salmon in rivers around Knight Inlet. Black bears roam the forests of both the Atlantic and Pacific coastlines, and the spectacular Polar bear can be spotted around Churchill in Manitoba and out on the tundra of Arctic Canada. You're bound to see other wildlife on your bear watching adventures, so keep an eye out for elk, moose, caribou and mountain goats. Wildlife spotting doesn't get much wilder than this!



ICEFIELDS PARKWAY

Stretching 232 kilometres through the heart of the Canadian Rockies, the Icefields Parkway offers the road trip of a lifetime. This spectacular drive between Jasper and Lake Louise, winds its way through Jasper and Banff National Parks and reveals natural attractions at every turn. Get a photo at world-famous Moraine Lake, see the bright turquoise colour of Peyto Lake, and view the powerful Athabasca and Sunwapta Falls. Take an Ice Explorer ride out onto the Columbia Icefield, step on this impressive ice mass, and dare to walk the glass-floored Skywalk.






OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

With its craggy peaks, iridescent lakes and twisting and turning trails, Canada is a haven for outdoor adventure. Lace up the boots and hike to Lake Agnes Tea House for views of Lake Louise or take to the trails in Whistler and Sun Peaks for meadows of wildflowers. Pedal your way along cityside pathways such as The Seawall in Vancouver or the Rideau Canal in Ottawa, or pick up the pace at Whistler Mountain Bike Park. On the water, kayak on Maligne Lake in Alberta or raft down the rushing waters of the Athabasca River. Try ziplining, bungee jumping and parasailing – there's no shortage of adventure here!





NATURAL WONDERS

Mother nature has blessed Canada with some of the greatest spectacles. See the immense power of Niagara Falls from above or below. Discover one of the biggest finds of dinosaur fossils at Dinosaur Provincial Park in Alberta. Check out the world's highest tides in New Brunswick, where you can kayak at high tide and walk on the ocean floor at low tide. An experience not to be missed is seeing the beautiful Northern Lights as they light up the night sky. Chase them in the Yukon, the Northwest Territories and Manitoba where viewing is best from February to March.

WHALE WATCHING

Canada's coastline offer some of the best places in the world to view the incredible whale. Over 30 species reside in, or travel along, the waters on both the east and west coasts. Humpback, minke, orca and blue whales can be found in the Pacific waters in the west, or the Atlantic Ocean or St Lawrence River in the east. The playful and gentle beluga whale can be seen at the estuary of the Churchill River near Hudson Bay in Manitoba. Amazing photo opportunities can be had from selected shorelines, or head out onto the water with an eco-friendly kayak or boat tour.

From big cities to enchanting towns and remote villages, these unique communities are waiting to be explored. Choose a cosmopolitan city break with no shortage of attractions in Vancouver or Toronto. IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF YUKON PIONEERS 11 DAYS

WHITEHORSE – WATSON LAKE – CARMACKS – DAWSON CITY – BEAVER CREEK – HAINES JUNCTION – WHITEHORSE

Day 1: Whitehorse Today, discover Whitehorse, the Yukon Territory's capital. See the historical buildings and city attractions, as well as the historical and cultural remnants of earlier times. Overnight in Whitehorse.

Day 2: Whitehorse to Watson Lake – 438km Drive to Watson Lake, situated in the rolling hills of southeast Yukon. See the Sign Post Forest with more than 77,000 signs from around the world, and the interesting World War II historical display. Overnight in Watson Lake.

Day 3: Watson Lake to Carmacks – 584km Take a scenic drive to Carmacks on the Alaska Highway. If time permits stop in Faro to visit the Campbell Region Interpretative Centre to learn about the history, mining heritage, wildlife and geology of the area. Overnight in Carmacks.

Day 4: Carmacks to Dawson City – 355km Travel into the heart of the northern Gold Rush, Dawson City. See the restored period buildings and perhaps spend the evening at the entertaining Diamond Tooth Gerties – a traditional gambling hall and saloon. Stay the next two nights in Dawson City.

Day 5: Dawson City Today explore more of this old gold mining town. See the interesting Bonanza Creek

Discovery Claim and Dredge 4 National Historic Site.

Day 6: Dawson City to Beaver Creek – 434km Take the Yukon River ferry crossing, travel on the Taylor Highway via the unique town of Chicken to the small town of Beaver Creek. Overnight in Beaver Creek.

Day 7: Beaver Creek to Haines Junction – 291km Explore the shores of Lake Kluane and the hiking trails of the beautiful Kluane National Park. Overnight in Haines Junction.

Day 8: Haines Junction Free day to explore or perhaps pay a visit to the Champagne and Aishihik First Nations' Da $K_{\underline{U}}$ Cultural Centre. Overnight in Haines Junction.

Day 9: Haines Junction to Whitehorse – 154km Travel the short distance to Whitehorse this morning. Enjoy the Long Ago People's Place First Nations guided tour and see first-hand how First Nations people lived. Stay the next two nights in Whitehorse.

Day 10: Whitehorse Today is free to explore Whitehorse at leisure. See the SS Klondike, Beringia Centre and MacBride Museum.

Day 11: Whitehorse Enjoy a final morning in Whitehorse.
